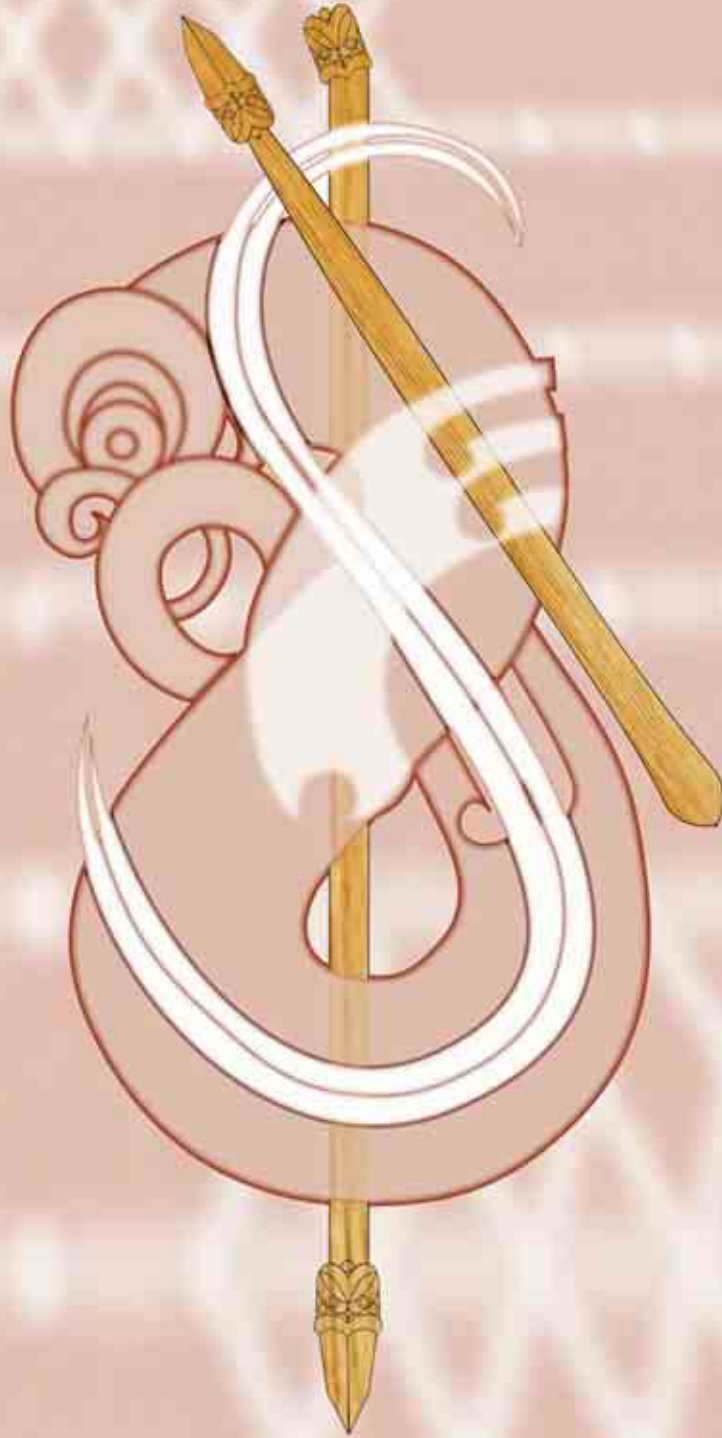

Study Māori business and management

The National qualifications in Māori Business and Management have been established to support the development of Māori business and to build a specifically Māori perspective on the business world. These qualifications recognise skills and knowledge in Māori business concepts and processes. Holders of these qualifications will be able to demonstrate understanding of tikanga and kawa in a management or administrative role in a marae or business environment.

What are the national qualifications in Māori Business and Management?

There are two national qualifications in Māori Business and Management:

- National Certificate in Māori Business and Management (level 4)
- National Diploma in Māori Business and Management (level 5).

These two uniquely Māori qualifications have been developed by the New Zealand Qualifications Authority (NZQA) in consultation with experts in Māori business and management.

People holding both the Certificate and Diploma will attain advanced skills, knowledge and competence required for people to apply kawa and tikanga in business processes in a wide range of roles in business, community or marae-based settings.

Where can I study Māori business and management?

National qualifications registered on the National Qualifications Framework (NQF) are only available from education providers that are registered with NZQA and accredited to offer national qualifications.

To find out which providers are accredited to offer national qualifications in Māori Business and Management you can go to the NZQA website www.nzqa.govt.nz or www.kiwiquals.govt.nz. These websites also include information on other qualifications available in field Māori.

Information for learners

National Certificate in Māori Business and Management (level 4)

This National Certificate is for people seeking a career in Māori business, or for those who are already in a Māori business or management environment (paid or voluntary).

The qualification recognises skills and knowledge in Māori business concepts and processes. Holders of this qualification will be able to demonstrate understanding of tikanga and kawa in a management or administrative role in a marae or business environment.

The Māori components of the course include Māori finance, Māori management (generic), Māori management in Māori organisations and Māori office systems.

National Diploma in Māori Business and Management (level 5) *With an optional strand in iwi management*

This National Diploma recognises the advanced skills, knowledge and competence required for people to apply kawa and tikanga in business processes in a wide range of roles in business, community or marae settings.

The core compulsory section recognises the underpinning skills and knowledge required of people looking for work in this field. The elective component provides flexibility to tailor the qualification to recognise competence in broader business, computing and Māori applications. The qualification also provides an optional strand in iwi management, for people working in management roles in rūnanga, hapū and marae.

The National Diploma builds on the National Certificate in Māori Business and Management, and provides a pathway to other specialist business qualifications.



What are the benefits of studying towards national qualifications in Māori Business and Management?

- **Recognition** – have your Māori skills, learning and knowledge formally recognised nationally and internationally.
- **Work at your level of expertise** – for example, there is no need to complete a level 4 qualification before starting on a level 5 qualification.
- **Expert development** – nationally recognised Māori experts develop and monitor all the unit standards in field Māori.
- **Quality assurance** – national standards and qualifications are developed and rigorously checked through a registration process, and assessments are moderated for national consistency.
- **Flexibility** – you can earn credits while you work or while you study at an accredited provider, or choose a combination of both.
- **Portability** – credits from the National Certificate or National Diploma in Māori Business and Management can count towards other national qualifications on the NQF and vice versa.
